1. Introduction

Please read the following *Application Guidelines* before submitting an application.

The aim of the **Kyushu Summer Institute in Law & Innovation** is to offer students, legal professionals or other interested parties an opportunity to study a selection of courses clustered around the theme of innovation and the law. Rapid technological change has emerged as a key feature of contemporary economic and social life, and the law has been forced to adapt to this new reality. The result has been significant recent legal reforms across multiple jurisdictions and all fields of law. In this program, a number of specially tailored courses offered within the framework of the International Economic & Business Law *LL.M.* program will examine, in detail, some of the implications of technological innovation for the law.

Courses will be taught by both Japanese and international faculty, and those who successfully complete the program will be awarded a *Diploma in Law & Innovation* issued by Kyushu Summer Institute.

2. Admission Requirements

For admission to the Kyushu Summer Institute, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. A degree in Law from an accredited university. Please note that students with a degree from a subject other than law are also very welcome to apply. Please explain in Section 5 of the Application Form your particular reasons for wanting to participate.
2. A good command of English. There is no formal requirement, but a TOEFL score of 237+ (computer-based), 580+ (paper-based), or 92+ (Internet-based) or

equivalent would be appropriate for non-native English speakers.

3. Sufficient financial support for the duration of the program. Further details on the costs of studying on the Summer Institute, including tuition and other costs, are available at the web site.

Application materials will **not** be returned to applicants.

4. Notification of Result

Applicants will be informed of the result of their application within 10 days of the receipt of application.

5. Warning

Successful applicants will have their enrollment in the Summer Program withdrawn immediately in the event of **any** of the following:

- If the applicant is found to have made false statements on his/her application.
- If the applicant is subject to disciplinary measures by the University.
- If the applicant is absent from University for a prolonged period of time without permission.
- If the student has insufficient resources to finance their studies in Kyushu University.
